

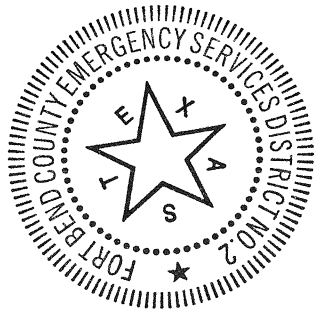
NOTICE OF PUBLIC MEETING

Notice is hereby given that **FORT BEND COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 2** will hold a meeting on **June 21, 2022, at 6:00 p.m.**, at the following location in the District: **Willowfork Fire Department, 26950 Cinco Ranch Blvd., Katy, Texas 77494.**

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order.
2. Roll call and establish a quorum.
3. To receive public comment.
4. To approve the Minutes of prior meeting(s).
5. To review and act on financial matters, including financial reports, financial condition of the District, investments, depositories and other accounts, audits, and Investment Policy.
6. To pay the District's bills, including approval of commissioner fees and expense reimbursements.
7. To designate the Fort Bend County Tax Assessor-Collector's Office to prepare the District's No New Revenue Tax Rate and related tax rate calculations for 2022.
8. To authorize District counsel to publish the necessary 2022 Tax Rate setting notices.
9. To review and act on the First Amendment to the 2021 Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the Collection of Taxes between Fort Bend County and the District.
10. To receive a report from Ricardo Martinez of Martinez Architects and act on District construction matters, including the approval of any pay Applications or Change Orders related to the District's construction projects.
11. To receive a report from Fire Chief on operations and activities.
12. To review, discuss and act on authorization of Automatic Aid Agreements.
13. To review, discuss and act to approve acquisitions or repairs related to Department facilities, apparatus, equipment, software, supplies, and training.
14. To review, discuss and act on adjustments to the District's insurance policies, including automobile liability, professional liability, workers compensation and health benefits.
15. To review, discuss and act for the sale or disposal of surplus and/or salvage of and other property pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §775.0735 including, but not limited to, any expired or damaged gear.
16. Review, discuss and act on Volunteer Awards dinner.
17. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding pending or contemplated litigation, settlement offers or on matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas and Tax Code §323.3022 to discuss sales tax matters.

18. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
19. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
20. To act on matters discussed in closed session.
21. To discuss and confirm the next regular monthly meeting date as well as any items that need to be on the next meeting agenda
22. Adjournment.
